



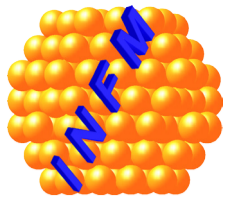

The project aims to establish, from a coordinated and integrated approach, interoperability in field activities conducted in the cross-border area by Romanian and Bulgarian specialized Police structures immediately after an event implying chemical-biological-radiological-nuclear-high yield explosives (CBRNe), by endowment of specialized police units with intervention means and dedicated detection equipment, at EU standards and requirements.

Strengthening the assessment capacity on effects of CBRNe events is a concomitant aim of project, which upholds the establishing, within a leading national research institution, of an “environmental forensics laboratory” by provision of complex equipment for laboratory analysis of samples collected by emergency response police units.
